- iii) It is the responsibility of the applicant to familiarise themselves with the licensed area boundaries. Vehicular access to view the licence area is subject to agreement with the Forest Manager.
- iv) Proposed deer cull figures (deer licences only) are provided as a guide only of the maximum permitted cull level. No assurances are made that these figures are achievable, and these cull figures may vary annually.
- v) The onus is on the applicant to determine the value of these rights for themselves and to base their tender bid accordingly.
- vi) The bid offered is final and is non-negotiable following acceptance.
