


### Coillte Web Map Application User Guide

# What does this web map application do?



It allows users to view areas of interest to them, where proposed tree felling activity will take place during 2016-2020. Users can also submit queries to relevant Coillte personnel directly from the application.




### How do I use the application?



#### **Step 1: Homepage**

- When you arrive at the homepage, a splash screen will display details regarding the purpose of the web map.
- Click OK to close the splash screen.




- You can navigate around the map area to find areas of interests to you and to view proposed timber felling activity during 2016-2020.
- As you zoom in closer, more detail will be displayed on the map.

### How do I use the application?




#### **Point of Interest**

To view a specific area on the map, click in the Find address of place box in the top left of the screen.



- Enter the name of an area.
- A drop down list will appear with predictions based on the text entered.




- Click on the relevant result listed.
- The map will then zoom to and centre on the selected area.

### How to view timber felling activity?



#### **Clearfell Areas**

- Forest areas where timber felling will occur, will appear on the map as you zoom in.
- Areas where clearfelling is proposed are coloured in pink. Although the full forest area may be coloured in pink, this does not mean the entire area will be felled.
- Click on a pink coloured area to view the percentage of the area proposed for clearfell.




### How to view timber felling activity?



#### **Thinning Areas**

- This is similar to the clearfell areas, although the full forest area may have a blue and white pattern, this does not mean the entire area will be thinned.
- Click on a blue and white pattern area to view the percentage of the area proposed for thinning.



### How to view timber felling activity?




#### **Clearfell and Thinning Areas**

Many areas may have proposed clearfell and thinnings operations for the period of the plan. These
will appear coloured in pink and with a blue pattern. Although the full forest area may be coloured in
pink and have a blue pattern, this does not mean the entire area will be clearfelled and thinned.

 Click on a pink coloured area with a blue pattern to view the percentage of the area proposed for both activities. Click on the white arrow in the pop up window to toggle between clearfell and thinning

percentages.



## **Navigation Tools**



#### There are 6 navigation tools:

| 1. | + | Zoom In                 | Click on the icon to zoom in. Alternatively you can use the scroll wheel on your mouse, scroll forward to zoom in.    |
|----|---|-------------------------|---|
| 2. | _ | Zoom Out                | Click on the icon to zoom out. Alternatively you can use the scroll wheel on your mouse, scroll backward to zoom out. |
| 3. |   | Pan                     | Click and drag the mouse to move the map in any direction.  |
| 4. | A | Zoom to Initial Extent  | Displays the full extent of the map.  |
| 5. | + | Zoom to Previous Extent | This will return to the previous display.   |
| 6. | + | Zoom to Next Extent     | This will return to the map displayed before using previous extent.   |
