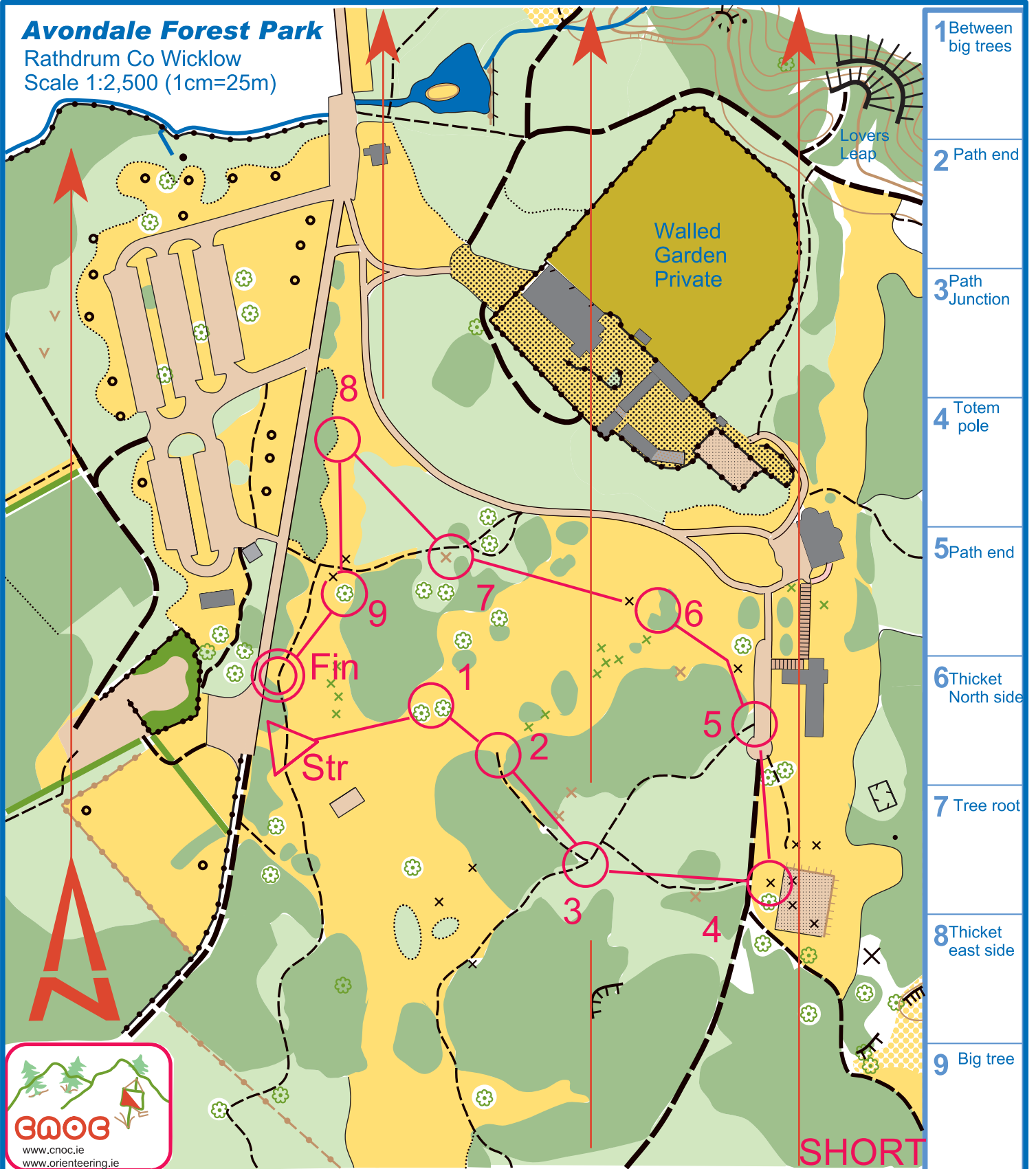


Avondale Forest Park

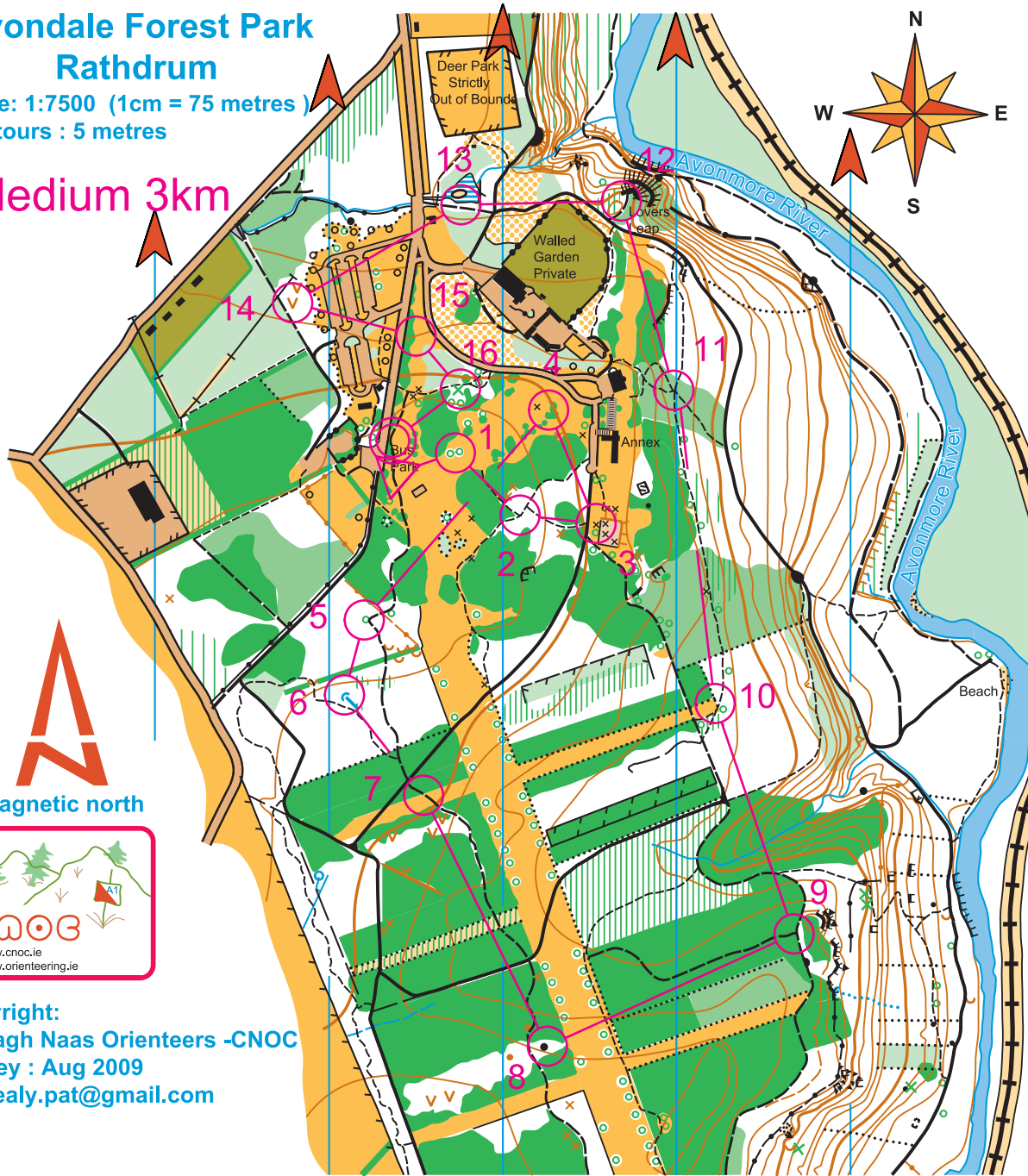

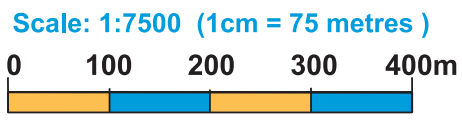
